Dr. Bruce and Mrs. Carolyn Hindmarsh will lead a four-week Sunday school series on the subject of spiritual reading, or *lectio divina*, to use the time-honoured Latin phrase for this practice. Spiritual reading is really all about prayerful reading with a desire to know God better and grow spiritually. It is reading for life. This series will explore both the theology and history of spiritual reading, and it will provide concrete examples and practical suggestions to deepen our own devotional reading of Scripture.



Bruce Hindmarsh is a professor of Spiritual Theology, at Regent College. He has since published and spoken widely to international audiences on the history of early British evangelicalism.
