Questions for personal or small group study and reflection:

1. What characteristics did Nehemiah look for when he chose men to be in positions of authority/leadership?
2. What does it mean to have integrity and to fear God? Do you fear the Lord? What does that really look like?
3. Why is the work not done within the wall? What has yet to be done? Do you resonate with Nehemiah's vision to see people fill the city? How can you help the church to reach its goal of transforming our city for Christ?
4. What keeps you from maintaining a close relationship with God? Are your senses tuned to God's prompting?
5. What did it mean for the people to have their names on the original register? What spiritual reality is pictured here? What are the consequences of not being on the register? (7:61-65)
6. How did the Christian faith enter into your family; how's it being passed down from one generation to the next?
7. What do you want your legacy of faith to be like? What kind of spiritual lineage are you building into your family line? By the grace/mercy of God, how can you be more proactive in pursuing and praying for this to take place?
8. What things in your life “seem dead” at this time? What are you asking God to revive, renew, restore, redeem?
